## 7 DAYS CAMPING ACTIVITIES 'Jaivam 2017'

'Jaivam' educates on chemical-free farm practices . The Inter University Centre for Organic Farming and Sustainable Agriculture at the MG University organized the massive Jaivam programme. Jaivam project was conceived as complimentary to the larger Haritha Kerala Mission of the State government. 'Jaivam' is a unique public education programme on organic means of living and chemical-free farm practices covering each household.



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As per their invitation and directions, Kannur University also decided to conduct Jaivam 2017 Project at Pinarayi Panchayath as part of the 7 days special camping programme. It was a joint venture of three colleges( 4 Units) : Chinmaya Arts And Science College For Women( 1 unit), MG College Chendayad(1 Unit) , and Don Bosco College Angadikkadavu (2 Units).

The aim of the camp was the public education in all the 19 wards of Pinarayi Panchayath. Each house visit includes an awareness talk, survey, distributing Jaivam booklet, understanding the problems they face in their farming, providing solutions etc. They also paste a Jaivam sticker at the gate to mark it as visited. Apart from these, the volunteers themselves get awared of these organic farming techniques. By talking with these many people, the personality of the volunteer also improves.

The Objectives can be listed as 1) To establish rapport with the people in the project area; 2) Identify needs, problems and resources of the community; 3) plan programmes and carry out the plans;4)relate learning and experience towards finding solutions to the problems identified; and 5)Record the activities systematically and assess the progress periodically.



The camp was conducted from 23<sup>rd</sup> December to 29<sup>th</sup> December 2017 at AKG Memorial Govt. Higher Secondary School, Pinarayi. The co-operation of

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the Panchayath President Ms. Geethamma and all the ward members was highly appreciable. They agreed to provide lunch for the volunteers at the ward itself. From the second day to the 5<sup>th</sup> day, each unit visited 1 ward, thus covered 16 wards. On the 6<sup>th</sup> day, Chinmaya students engaged in cleaning near by areas, MG Chendayad visited one ward and two units of Donbosco covered one ward. Ward 19, house visit was completed by DIA College, Paral. Thus we could successfully finish the target.

**Day 1: 23<sup>rd</sup> December**



The volunteers after getting them selves registered at 1 pm, cleaned their allotted rooms and lined up in the camping dress code (White Jaivam T Shirt and Jaivam cap bearing 'Jaivam' logo) for the declaration procession at 2.30 pm in front of the camping site at AKG Memorial Higher Secondary School, Pinarayi. The inaugural session commenced with NSS Geetham. Panchayath President Smt. Geethamma presided over the function. K.K. Rajeevan, Block Panchayath Presdient, inaugurated the camp.





Kannur University Pro Vice Chancellor, Dr. T Ashokan was the Chief Guest. M.R. Unni, Registrar, M.G. University and General Convener 'Jaivam' was the distinguished guest. Chinmaya Arts and Science College for Women Principal Dr. P A Valsala Kumari and Programme Convener Ms. Sheena welcomed the gathering.



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In the Volunteer Parliament, given the final orientation for the home visit. Also assigned duties for different groups.

**2<sup>nd</sup> Day: 24<sup>th</sup> December**

The second day commenced with Zumba dance. It delighted and gave a new energy for the volunteers.



Before leaving to the ward, an assembly was conducted, in which NSS song, Message and report of the previous day, were presented. Also all colleges published the camp paper. All students were distributed sufficient number of survey forms, Jaivam reference book and stickers. Each unit were allotted a ward for the house visit, and our college visited the 12<sup>th</sup> ward - Penankimetta on the first day.



The volunteers were given prior training in organic farming and camping activities which ensured smooth conduct of the camp. The ward members were very active in making the house visits swifter for the NSS volunteers. The ward member Ms. Sajitha ensured to provide lunch to the volunteers in their respective places.

Our student's target was 505 houses and by 3.30 they covered 443 houses. In the evening, Christmas Carol was conducted at Pinarayi town. Students also uploaded the data collected in the survey to the Jaivam website – [www.jaivam.iucofsa.ac.in](http://www.jaivam.iucofsa.ac.in). All days end with volunteer parliament, in which a review of that day was held. Also duties of the committees for the next day was decided.

### **3<sup>rd</sup> Day : 25<sup>th</sup> December**

The visit of Hon'ble Chief Minister Sri. Pinarayi Vijayan gave impetus to the camp besides bringing vibrancy and seriousness among the campers on the 'Jaivam' project. The CM was received with 'JAIVAM' T-Shirt and Cap.



The Chief Minister urged the students to reinvent the traditional agriculture resorting to modern scientific methods to ensure better and healthy living. The deteriorating health conditions of the people can be easily traced back to the toxic food items being available to be consumed, majority of which comes from neighboring states. This situation can easily be reserved by ensuing self sufficiency in food items including fruits and vegetables. The Chief Minister called for continuous vigilance on food, agriculture and health practices to create a vibrant new Kerala.





At the time of Ward visit, our volunteers also participated in the stone foundation ceremony of Balabhavan Building. Chief minister inaugurated the same. Our volunteers welcomed CM by giving flowers. Also our volunteers got a chance to interact with Hon'ble Health Minister Ms. Shylaja Teacher.



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Of the 518 houses of Venduttayi ward ( Ward 6), we covered 422 houses. The ward member arranged Biriyani as lunch for the volunteers. Being the Christmas day, Donbosco College Principal sponsored cake for all the volunteers. Also the program – Group Dynamics by Mr. Sayeed K P of Phoenix Talipparamba, helped to strengthen the bond in between the volunteers.



#### 4<sup>th</sup> Day : 26<sup>th</sup> December

On the fourth day, our volunteers were assigned ward 2- Edakkadavu. After physical exercise and assembly, by 9.30 ward member Ms. Prameela co-ordinated the ward visit. 445 houses were our target, of which we completed 409 houses.



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In the evening, a session on 'Vijaya Manthranam' was handled by Mr. Rajeevan Vengad, Senior Police Officer. Also Kannur University NSS Programme Coordinator Sri. Padmanabhan Kavumbayi visited our camp and addressed the volunteers.

### **5<sup>th</sup> Day: 27<sup>th</sup> December**

After physical exercise and assembly, by 9.30, we started the house visit. We were allotted ward 15 – Kizhakkumbhagam. Ward member Ms. Rajila coordinated the ward visit. Our target was 444 houses and we could complete 376.



A documentary screened on 27<sup>th</sup> night made the volunteers more vibrant in the camp. Evening cultural programmes were filled with fun and frolic.

### **6<sup>th</sup> Day : 28<sup>th</sup> December**

On the 6<sup>th</sup> day, Our volunteers involved in cleaning school campus and school to Pinarayi road. They also updated the survey data in Jaivam website.



The 'Kalasandhya' held on 28<sup>th</sup> was a remarkable vision feast of art and culture which out smarted all the participants and they inspired by seeing the massive participation of the public.

**7<sup>th</sup> Day : 29<sup>th</sup> December**

Sri Ramachandran Kadannappally, Minister for Ports and Archeology inaugurated the valedictory meeting on December 29 who declared Pinarayi Grama Panchayath as the first Organic Literate Panchayath in Kannur District.



Our Camp Magazine named 'Narumozhi' was released on the occasion. also wrote his message in the magazine. The camp ended with rendering of National Anthem.
